

What do the databases contain?

EBSCOhost – EBSCOhost databases offer full-text coverage of peer-reviewed, scholarly journals and authoritative research reports and studies for all disciplines.

Facts on File – Brings together complete content from the Fact on File World News Digest and a live newsfeed from Reuters to answer questions about events, people, issues, facts, and figures from 1940 to the present. Also delivers maps, photographs, historic documents, and special overviews of key issues, newsmakers, and events since 1940 and links to related articles.

Foundation Grants – Find sources to scholarships, fellowships, grants, awards and other financial support, online devoted exclusively to foundations that fund individuals.

Hoover's Pro – Business information for student research, comprehensive company information, key executives biographies, analyze complete industry coverage, view detailed company fact sheets with financials, executives and description.

JStor – Offers both interdisciplinary and discipline-specific collections in the social sciences. Includes 1,856, 206 full text articles across 47 disciplines, there are 1,387,437 book reviews and JStor's oldest content was published in 1665.

Lexis/Nexis – Full-text access to 10,000 sources, including regional, national and international newspapers, company profiles, case law, medicine and country reports.

Literature Resource Center (LRC) – LRC is a complete literature reference database: rich in biographical and critical content. LRC contains entries of many authors from all periods and from genres as fiction, nonfiction, poetry, drama, history, journalism and more. Contains *Contemporary Authors*, *Contemporary Literary Criticism Select (CLC)*, *Dictionary of Literary Biography*, *Drama for Students*, *Novels for Students*, etc.

Mergent Online – Tracks company, industry and country information in more countries than any other database, and delivers a comprehensive suite of authoritative financial information.

Novel – is a statewide virtual library provided free to the public by the New York State Library. It is currently a project funded through the Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) grant to the New York State Library by the Federal Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS).

ProQuest – is a general database that contains information from arts, literature, and social science to science, technology, and medicine.

Standard & Poor's NetAdvantage – is a high level research tool of business information, News & Commentary from S&P's analysts. Publications available are Industry Surveys, The Outlook, Stock Reports, Mutual Fund Reports, Register of Corporations and information on S&P 500, S&P Midcap, S&P SmallCap 600 indexes.

Wilson Web – contains general research information from Applied Science & Technology to World Authors.
