- Sign and submit your FAFSA before applying for TAP.
- Have your (and your spouse's) 2010 New York State Tax return IT-201 Line # 37, / IT-150 Line #25.
- If you live with your parents, you must have their 2010 New York State tax return.

Be prepared to answer the following:

- Marital status for you and parent.
- Spouses social security number.
- Month and year of parents disability if recent.
- Answer questions about pension income Received.

- First time users: must create a USER ID and password.
- Return users: retrieve your ID and reset your password by choosing
  - "I forgot my USER ID and password"
- Continue to sign in the HESC authentication System.
- Submit application.
- Select 2011-2012 TAP Application.

# FAFSA & TAP Guide

## 2011-2012

**Before you begin.  
What information do I need?**

- Eligible non-citizens need their alien registration number.
- Drivers License.
- Income information for you and your spouse (if married) for 2010 such as tax returns, W-2's, untaxed income information, child support received and bank and investment information.
- Dependent students: must answer questions about your parents marital status, social security number, date of birth and provide information about their income and assets.

**How do I know if I need parental information?  
Independent vs. Dependent**

You are **independent** if you answer "YES" to any of the following:

- Born before Jan 1st, 1988.
- Enrolled or will enroll in a Masters Program by Sept 2011.
- Are married.
- Have children who receive more than 1/2 financial support from you between July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.
- Have dependents other than children who live with you and receive more than 1/2 financial support from you now through June 30, 2012.

You are a **dependent** student if you answer "NO" to all of the above.

Meet with a Student Financial Services counselor if there are circumstances which prevent you from obtaining parental information.

**Completing your 2011-2012 FAFSA  
www.fafsa.gov**

- Use the FAFSA HOME PAGE to start your Application.
- Go to RENEWAL FAFSA for 2011-2012
- Check your Federal PIN status, select DUPLICATE PIN to display it.
- Use your Federal PIN to renew, transfer IRS tax data then sign your application.
- Dependent students; your parents can sign the FAFSA using their own Federal PIN.

**FAFSA FILING TIPS:**

**Application errors create delays with processing.**

- Are you male or female?  
Don't leave this blank
- Will you have your 1st Bachelor's degree before July 1, 2011?  
Don't answer "yes" UNLESS you already have your Bachelor's Degree as of the day you are completing your FAFSA.

- When you begin 2011-2012, what will be your grade level?  
Determine the number of credits you'll have by the ending of the semester.

- What degree program will you begin in 2011-2012?  
Associate, Bachelor's or Graduate (MBA / MS)
- Are you interested in Federal Work Study?  
Do not leave this blank.
- How do I answer information about my household size?  
⇒ If you are independent and have children, your household size always includes you and the children you will support between July 1, 2011 and June 30, 2012. This includes an unborn child that will be born during that period of time.  
⇒ If you are dependent, the household size includes you, your parent(s) and dependents your parents will support between July 1, 2011 and June 30, 2012.  
⇒ Household may also include dependents other than your child who live with you now and receive support between July 1, 2011 and June 30, 2012.

Support means housing, food, clothing, and actual cash contributions that provide housing, food and clothing.

Be prepared to answer information about your savings and wages from work even if its "0".

Do not leave the federal programs section blank such as SSI, Food Stamps, TANF, free or reduced price lunch, WIC.
