Partial Tuition Scholarship for an Associate in Culinary Arts or Baking and Pastry and a Bachelor's in Hospitality Management

The recipient of this scholarship will be determined based on the student's application to Monroe College and on a 500-word essay about their passion for culinary arts/baking & pastry and the career path they intend to take.

Scholarship Details:

- Scholarship coverage specifics: This is a partial academic tuition scholarship for the AAS Culinary Arts or AAS Baking and Pastry programs and the Bachelor's degree in Hospitality Management. **This scholarship covers academic tuition.** If Federal Aid is applied to the recipient's tuition, the remaining balance of this scholarship will be applied to other school-related expenses, such as room, board, and school books. This scholarship is renewable each semester, until the completion of the Associate Program and the Bachelor's program, as long as the recipient meets the requirements stated below.
- Federal Aid: All recipients must fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Scholarship Criteria and Requirements:

- Scholarship period: The scholarship recipient must **begin a full-time (12 credits or more) program of study at Monroe College in the Fall 2017 semester.** Recipients must be enrolled by **June 1, 2017.** If the recipient does not enroll before then, they will forfeit the scholarship. The recipient must be accepted into the Culinary Arts or Baking and Pastry Arts Associate in Applied Sciences program and the Bachelor's in Business Administration in Hospitality Management degree program. **Students must submit official high school transcripts, school attendance records, two letters of recommendation (one from a Hospitality instructor and one from a guidance counselor or school administrator), and a 500-word essay to Enmely Soriano at esoriano@monroecollege.edu.** The scholarship recipients must meet the admissions criteria for Monroe College, including an interview with the dean or his designee.
- Admissions/Eligibility criteria: Applicants must have a 3.0 cumulative high school GPA or higher in order to be eligible for this scholarship. The scholarship is only available to applicants who have applied to Monroe and whose ProStart applications have been approved by the school.
- Scholarship retention criteria: The scholarship recipient must maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and be enrolled as a full-time student. If a student's final grades for a given semester result in a cumulative GPA below 3.0, the student will lose their scholarship for the next semester they are enrolled. Students that change their major from the AAS in Culinary Arts, AAS in Baking and Pastry Arts, or BBA in Hospitality Management will forfeit their scholarship award.
